QUILT SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION

Guidelines for Submitting Quilts

Please ensure your entry meets the definition of a quilt. By definition, a quilt consists of a top, middle layer, and backing (American Quilting Society). The 3 layers are quilted in some manner – machine and/or hand running stitch. Tied quilts are accepted.

- **Deadline: Entry forms** must be received no later than **Thursday, July 9, 2026**. **Submissions must include a photo(s) with the entry form. Note: Make sure each submission is complete as there may not be time to perfect the missing information.**
- **Entry form:** Each quilt needs its own entry. Include **photo** with each entry form. Computer-printed quality is fine. Quilts may not be shown in consecutive years.
- **Prioritize Entries:** The show's capacity is 90 entries. Members may enter up to five items. The committee asks members to prioritize multiple entrees. **Priority: # _ of __ entries.** If there is only space for four entries per person, the quilt identified Priority: 5 of 5 entries will not be included in the show.
- **Submit entries: Only hardcopy entries are accepted.** Mail forms to Peaks 'n Pines Quilt Guild (address on entry form) or drop them off at the Fabric Nook during normal business hours. **NO** entries will be accepted after the deadline.
- **Non-Member fees:** There is a \$50 entry fee for a quilt submitted by non-Peaks 'n Pines guild members. Please attach a check to the entry form.
- **Dimensions:** Please indicate the length and the width of your quilt. If a quilt is longer or wider than 110 inches, it might be necessary to exhibit it folded.
- **Volunteer:** Your help is needed to volunteer during the quilt show itself (including set up/tear down), participate on a Quilt Show committee, work at the QOV table, or create items for the sales table. *There is a minimum of 2 volunteer hours per quilt entered.*
- **Label:** Each quilt must have a label sewn on the back to a lower corner. Include the exhibitor's name and the name of the quilt. This label should not be made of paper nor attached with a safety pin.
- **Sleeve:** Quilts will only be accepted with a sleeve the width of the quilt, including Art Quilts. (This must be 8" x full **width of the quilt**. Fold in half to

make a tube. Attach to the quilt.) Sleeves must be sewn across the top and bottom of the sleeve. No safety pins!

Note: sleeves are needed for the 2026 Quilt Challenge: Crazy Quilt. The challenge minimum size 12.5 inches x 12.5 inches. Maximum size 50 inches x 65 inches.

- **Pillowcase:** Each quilt must be submitted in a pillowcase, with one quilt per pillowcase. No trash bags! Place two LARGE safety pins near the top of each pillowcase. Label the pillowcase with the exhibitor's name and phone number.
- **Quilt drop off:** Drop quilts off from **Friday, July 17 through NOON Friday , July 24** at the Fabric Nook in Granby or with Jenny Dems.
- **Pick up:** Quilts **MUST** be picked up Sunday, August 2, from **4:45 to 5:15 p.m.** at the Grand Lake Center. Please indicate on the entry form who will be picking up your quilt. Note: Crazy Quilts that are to exhibited in the Cozen's Ranch Exhibit in October may be left with Vickie Rinn from the Cozen's Ranch Committee.
